BACKGROUND

Across five generations, the Battuello family's commitment to vine cultivation on their Napa Valley Estate remains steadfast. WINEMAKING

Hand-picked and meticulously sorted, our grapes undergo a 48-hour cold soak before yeast inoculation. Controlled fermentation temperatures, peaking at 85 degrees, preserve varietal character. Mid-fermentation, we lower temperatures for fruitiness and tannin control. Once delicately pressed, the wine ages for 22 months in about 80% new French oak.

Indulge in a luxurious tapestry of flavors, where the succulent essence of blueberry, the opulence of black cherry, and the subtle allure of tobacco combine to create an enticing symphony that dances upon the palate.
