

Since 1909 the Battuellos have believed that great wines are grown by careful hands and an intimate knowledge of the land fostered by working the soil vintage after vintage. To that end, our family has cultivated the same rocky soil in St. Helena for over 100 years, producing excellent grapes for award-winning wines in the region.

For five generations the Battuello Family has been growing vines in the northern Napa Valley. Battuello Vineyards, in St. Helena, was founded in 1909 by Matteo Battuello and his wife Serana, who immigrated to California from Favria, a town in the Piedmont region of northern Italy. In 1906, Matteo Battuello arrived in America by steamship, arriving at Ellis Island and then settling in New Mexico where he worked in the mining industry. He then joined friends in Napa Valley and bought some land in 1909. He started farming grapes, prunes and walnuts and then planted Zinfandel, Petite Sirah, Mondeuse Noire, Carignan, Napa Gamay (Valdiguié) and Alicanté Bouschet. His wife Serana joined him in 1912 and worked by his side running the property while they raised their sons Dominic and Joseph. Dominic and his wife Ellen inherited the property and bought additional adjacent property, expanding the vineyard. They raised their children Craig, Lois and Elaine on the farm.

Craig took over running the property and today his son Dave has joined him. Dave and his wife Torey are raising their children Case and Alessa on the family property today. In 2001 Craig purchased a neighboring parcel, expanding the estate to its current 82 acres. One notable building on the Battuello property is a barn built in the 1830s, designed by the same architect who designed St. Helena's Bale Grist Mill.

WINEMAKER MICHAEL TRUJILLO

Growing up on a ranch, Michael Trujillo worked acres of hay, barley and vegetables along with sheep and cattle on land tethered to his family for generations. His grandparents were early century homesteaders of Spanish descent who settled in the Rocky Mountain state of Colorado, where they raised their children in a rich, agricultural life.

Michael discovered his passion for winemaking in the early 1980s during a Spring break from his college studies as an engineer. On a road trip to California, he stayed with a family friend who had a small winery in Napa Valley. It proved to be a life changing visit. Michael's history, knowledge and experience, bringing his keen love of the vineyard together with more than 34 years of winemaking proficiency.
